

Proposed Procedure for Rowland E. Dorer Award

- 1) Awards Committee will be appointed by the President and should consist of three members to include, when possible, previous Dorer Award recipients.
- 2) Nominations for the award should be submitted to the Board of Directors, in care of the current President, by June 1.
- 3) Criteria for Dorer Award nominees are as follows:
 - a) Nominees for the award should be selected on the basis of their exceptional contributions of whatever type to mosquito control in the Mid-Atlantic Mosquito Control region.
 - b) The nominee must be a MAMCA member in good standing.
 - c) Nominees are to be submitted in writing with justification.
 - d) A maximum of one award per year will be given.
- 4) The Committee will review the nominees and make their recommendation to the President.
- 5) The President will present the Committee's recommendation to the Board of Directors for approval.
- 6) The Secretary-Treasurer will, at the President's request, be responsible for securing the plaque.
- 7) In addition to the plaque, any registration costs personally incurred by the recipient will be rebated following the presentation of the award. Costs paid by recipient's employer would not be rebated. The recipient will also be awarded a lifetime membership to MAMCA upon retirement.
